

Soaring Eagle Book Award

Seventh Grade – Twelfth Grade

Sponsored by the Wyoming Library Association and the Wyoming State Reading Council, the Soaring Eagle Book Award provides the opportunity for Wyoming youth in grades seven through twelve to select a favorite book (from a selected list of top nominations by students from the previous year) and honor the authors of those books.

The purpose of the Soaring Eagle Book Award format is to help Wyoming students in grades 7-12:

Become acquainted with the best contemporary authors.

Become aware of the qualities that make a good book.

Choose the best rather than the mediocre.

Set a goal to read at least three good books.

To honor an author whose books Wyoming students have enjoyed.
