Activities and Accomplishments

The Awards and Grants Committee met monthly this year starting in the spring via teleconference. All meeting agendas and notes are on the committee's wiki. We tried to send regular emails to remind and encourage people about recognizing their co-workers.

Changes to Awards

On the basis of last year's survey, we made a few minor adjustments to the awards slate this year:

- Renaming "Meritorious Service" to "Community Supporter:" We altered the name and criteria wording for this award to better reflect that it is given to someone outside the library system who supports it, and is not directly employed by said system.
- **Sectioning of the award list:** We split up the awards into three groups to make it easier to tell at a glance what the awards are for, by dividing them under Awards for Libraries, Awards for Librarians, and Awards for Others.

As 77 % of the survey respondents from spring 2013 said they were satisfied with the current awards, we did not eliminate nor did we add any.

Awards Nominations & Presentation

Once again we chose to get the award plaques made by Westwood High School in Gillette, Wyoming, and continue to be pleased with both the quality and economy of their work. The bulk of the awards were presented at the Awards Banquet Thursday evening, Sept. 25. The Community Service and Media Awards were presented at the Legislative Luncheon Thursday afternoon, Sept. 25
